Thank you for purchasing your admission to Highclere Castle. All visitors are welcome to enjoy the Gardens from 9:30am to 5:30pm. The Gift Shop and Tearooms are located in the Grounds and are open to visitors from 9:30am to 5:00pm.

Admission to the Castle and Egyptian Exhibition is dependent on your ticket type and the entrance time will be indicated on your ticket. Entry to the Castle and Egyptian Exhibition for holders of Morning Tickets can be any time between 10:00am and 12:30pm. Entry to the Castle and Egyptian Exhibition for holders of Midday Tickets can be any time between 12:30pm and 2:30pm. Entry to the Castle and Egyptian Exhibition for holders of Afternoon Tickets can be any time between 2:30pm and 4:00pm. Last admission to the Castle & Exhibition is at 4:00pm. We usually have an increase in numbers at the start of the morning and afternoon sessions, so you may wish to stagger your visit accordingly. If you have booked a Picnic Afternoon Tea Box, these can be collected between 12:00pm and 4:00pm from our Coach House Tea Room, located in the Courtyard.

A necessary carer of a registered, paying, disabled visitor is entitled to free admission in order to accompany the disabled visitor during the visit. We cannot accommodate motorised wheelchairs inside the Castle or Egyptian Exhibition, but you are welcome to reserve a manual wheelchair. Visitors should also be aware that some areas of the Egyptian Exhibition contain low levels of lighting. Please note, dogs are not permitted inside the Castle or grounds with the exception of guide/assistance dogs with the appropriate documentation and livery. Photography is not permitted inside the Castle.
